Unicamp Board of Directors Meeting Report May 12, 2022 on Zoom

(This is an unofficial report on the content of the meeting, prepared by Secretary Helen Iacovino. Official minutes will be posted after approval at the June meeting.)

A letter has been sent to congregations and 2021 delegates informing them of a special meeting on Saturday, June 18 at 10:00 am on Zoom to consider some By-Law changes, including one that will allow Unicamp to hold the Annual General Meeting on Zoom if desired. Also on the agenda is the 8th Principle, as approved in 2021 by the Canadian Unitarian Council.

Two representatives from the Natural Burial Association addressed the Board to present information about the possibility of creating a natural burial ground at Unicamp. This is at the "ideas" stage at present; nothing would be done without a long process and extensive consultation with the community.

Unicamp has once again received a generous Canada Summer Jobs Grant.

The Charter Review Committee, which is chaired by Dianne Heise, will be holding focus groups to solicit input from the Board and the wider community.

A process will be put into place to document and carry over the knowledge about the property that different people have, so it is all in one place.

The Board moved approval for the estimate for Rosie's cottage as presented at \$7,000.

The Board moved to accept Jeffrey Dickhout as Interim Treasurer until a new Treasurer is found.
