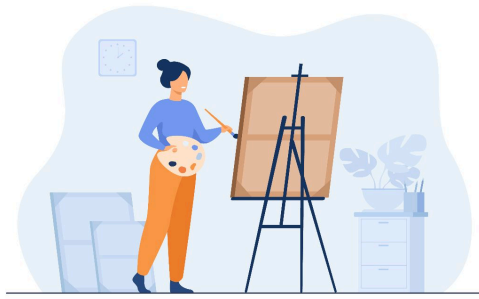

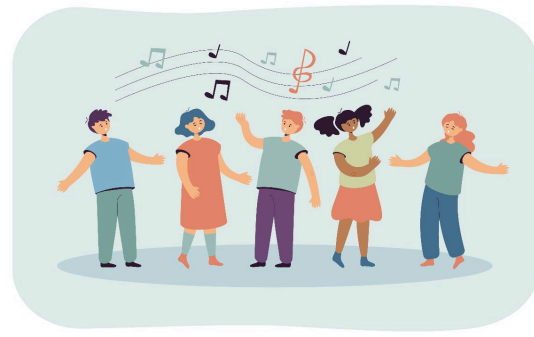
Poet-in-Residence

inspired by the world's religious symbols? Or by one of our 8

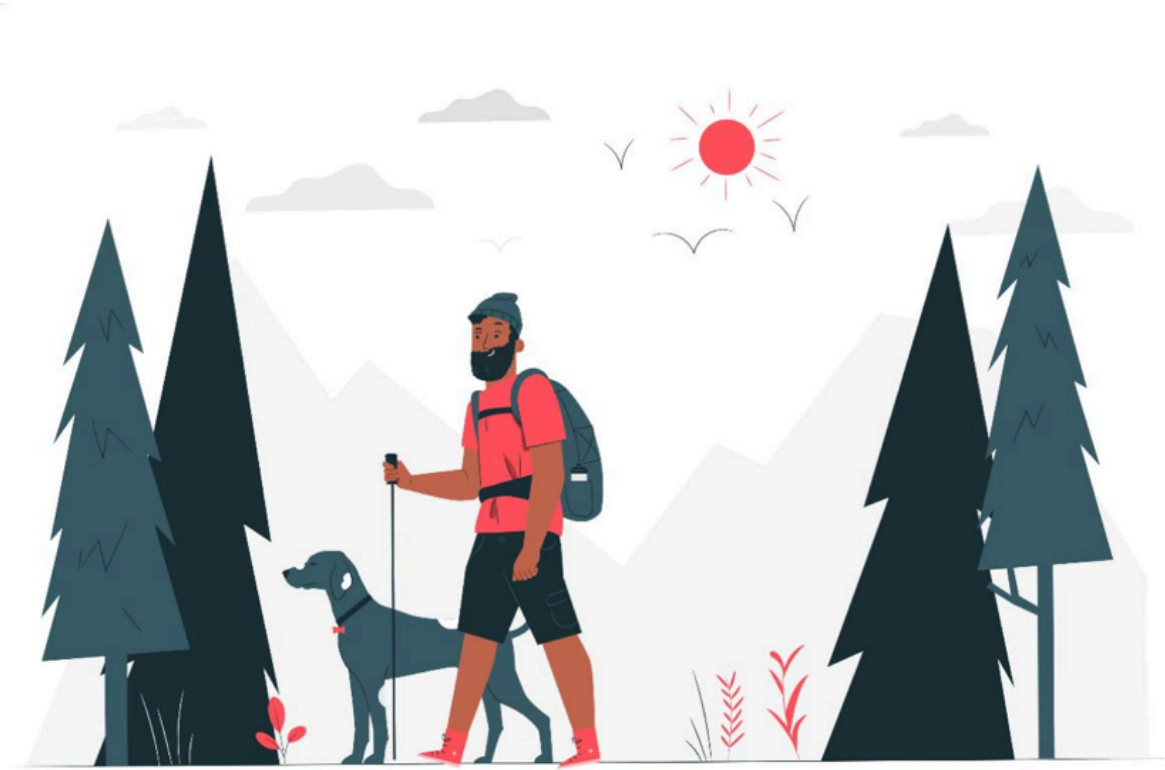
